A BYLAW TO SUPPLEMENT THE GENERAL DUTIES OF THE MAYOR

The Council of the Town of Kipling in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

This Bylaw may be referred to as the Mayoral Bylaw.

DEFINITIONS

- 1. In this Bylaw:
 - a. "Act" shall mean *The Municipalities Act, 2005*
 - b. "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the Municipality
 - c. "Council" shall mean the Council of the Municipality
 - d. "Mayor" shall mean the person who has been elected to the office of Mayor of the Municipality
 - e. "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Kipling

DUTIES

- 2. In addition to those duties conferred by Act, the Mayor may:
 - a. Upon vacating the chair to the Deputy Mayor present or second a motion for consideration by Council;
 - b. Take part in debate of a motion before Council;
 - c. Suspend any municipal employee, not including the Administrator, for cause, and subsequent thereto shall report to Council at its next meeting the suspension and the reasons for that action to the Council, which shall then reinstate or dismiss the suspended employee;
 - d. Authorize the removal, without warrant, of any vehicle that, in his or her opinion, is parked or left on a municipal road at a place or in any manner that constitutes a hazard to other users of the road or road allowance or unduly interferes with construction, maintenance or snow removal

- operations and cause the said vehicle to be relocated to a suitable place where it no longer constitutes a hazard or interferes with construction, maintenance or snow removal operations;
- e. The Mayor shall sign all cheques, agreements and negotiable documents on behalf of the municipality along with the Administrator.
- 3. Notwithstanding the general duties conferred by Section 93 of the Act:
 - a. When present, the Mayor shall preside at regular and special meetings of Council; and
 - b. The Mayor is an ex officio member of Council Committees or any other body established by Council.

REPEALING CLAUSE

Bylaw 15-2012 is hereby repealed.

COMING INTO FORCE

6. This Bylaw shall come into effect on the day of its final passing.
