BYLAW NO. 8-2005



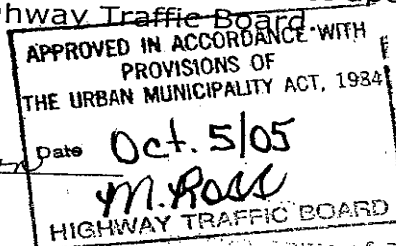
A BYLAW TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF KIPLING.

The Council of the Town of Kipling, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful to operate a Golf Cart during the hours between sunrise and one half hour after sunset on all public highways within the limits of the Town of Kipling, with the exception of that portion of Main Street between Fifth Avenue and Seventh Avenue and portion of Highway # 48/Railway Street between the East Boundary of the Town and West Boundary of the Town.
2. Persons operating a golf cart on the public highways within the limits of the Town of Kipling must be using the Golf Cart for the sole purpose of transportation to and from the Golf course, by the direct shortest distance between the Golf Course and where the golf cart is stored.
3. Golf carts shall carry a slow moving warning device at the rear, as near to the centre as practicable with one side parallel to and not less than 300 millimeters nor more than 1200 millimeters from the ground.
4. No persons shall operate a golf cart on the public highways within the limits of the Town of Kipling without a valid driver's license.
5. All personal and public liability will be the responsibility of the owner/operator of the said golf cart.
6. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00.
7. Bylaw 3-00 is hereby repealed.
8. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval thereof by the Highway Traffic Board
